

SIGNS YOUR HVAC SYSTEM NEEDS REPAIR



WEAK OR INCONSISTENT AIRFLOW

Poor airflow could indicate clogged filters, ductwork issues, or a failing blower motor.



UNUSUAL NOISES FROM THE UNIT

Banging, rattling, or screeching sounds may signal loose components, a failing motor, or compressor issues.



If your system turns on and off too frequently, it could be due to thermostat malfunctions or dirty condenser coils.





UNEXPLAINED INCREASE IN ENERGY BILLS

A sudden spike in your energy bill may mean your system is working harder due to inefficiency.

UNPLEASANT ODORS COMING FROM THE VENTS

Musty, burning, or foul smells could indicate mold growth, electrical issues, or dirty air filters.

EXCESS HUMIDITY OR LEAKS AROUND THE UNIT

Moisture buildup or leaking water could mean a clogged drain line or refrigerant leak.
